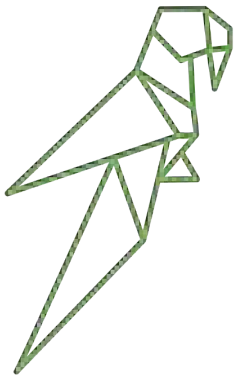

Act 60 & 22 Charitable Donations

- As an Act 60 Investor, starting in your 2nd year you **must donate at least \$10,000** annually to a local Puerto Rican non profit.
 - Half of that donation (\$5,000) can go to **any** approved Puerto Rican **1101.01** non profit.
 - The other half (\$5,000) must go to an [approved CECFL non profit organization](#).
- Some Act 22 Investors have an obligation to donate \$5,000/year, which does not have to include a CECFL org.
- You can't donate to a non profit that you own or control.
- All investors can donate to one or more organizations so long as it adds up to the required amount.
- All donations must be **completed by** the end of the calendar year, **December 31**.
- Be sure to **get receipts** from the non profit to file with your CPA at the end of the year.

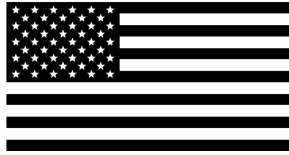

The State of Puerto Rico & Education



[Puerto Rico is a US territory](#), meaning everyone here is an American citizen. It has been apart of the US before Arizona was a state. It has USPS, NPS, and Costco. It's also officially bilingual.



Puerto Rican teachers make [the lowest salaries](#) of any other American teacher by nearly double. This means most leave to the mainland.



The average Puerto Rican student scores between [3-5 grade levels lower](#) than the average mainland student, and is one of the poorest performers globally [scoring lower than Mexico and Thailand](#).



Puerto Rico is America's [third largest school district](#) serving over 400,000 American students.



The US government gives [Puerto Rico 3.5B every year](#) for their education system. However, inefficiency & [corruption is a huge problem](#), so the money doesn't always make it to the schools.




More than 90% of Puerto Rican schools do not meet the federal guidelines for academic achievement, including [technology](#).
